**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BERKELEY, MISSOURI, AMENDING
SCHEDULE XIIA – DEFINING ONE WAY STREETS; BY AUTHORIZING THE
CLOSURE OF MADISON AVENUE AT FOURTH AVENUE, ELIMINATING THE ONE
WAY IN SAINT LOUIS COUNTY, BERKELEY, MISSOURI**

Section 1. The closure is highlighted and shown on Attachment 1 is hereby approved to close off the One-Way at the Fourth Avenue entrance with concrete barricades.
