**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BERKELEY, MISSOURI, AMENDING
ORDINANCE NO. 4056 ENTITLED LIMITING THE NUMBER OF
GARNISHMENTS AN EMPLOYEE IS ALLOWED IN THE CITY OF BERKELEY
PROVIDING COLLECTION FEES AND PENALTIES THEREOF**

WHEREAS, the number of employee garnishments are rising and the cost to process is currently being paid through the city.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BERKELEY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The processing fee for each new and current garnishment shall be at a cost to the employee at each payroll processing.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.

☐ Section 130.050 **Limiting the Number of Garnishments an Employee Is Allowed.**

[Ord. No. 4056 §§1 — 2, 6-18-2012]

- A. It shall be the policy of the City of Berkeley, Missouri that any employee who has in excess of two (2) garnishments on their wages shall be subject to discharge/termination.
- B. Any current garnishments that are in excess of the limitation of this Section shall not be counted. *“Current”* shall mean existing on the date of the passage of this Section.
