AN ORDINANCE FOR THE CITY OF BERKELEY MISSOURI RENAMING INDEPENDENCE PARK AT 8247 ADDINGTON ROAD TO WILLIAM MILLER CITY PARK

WHEREAS, Independence Park was acquired in 1970 by the City of Berkeley and has been used continuously as a public park; and
