**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BERKELEY, MISSOURI, REPEALING
ORDINANCE 4706 RENAMING SHORT PARK TO WILLIE MAE ANTHONY
NEIGHBORHOOD PARK**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BERKELEY,
MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Ordinance 4706 “Renaming Short Park to Willie Mae Anthony Neighborhood Park”, received final passage by the Council on April 18, 2022, is hereby repealed.

Section 2. The City shall erect signage, in appropriate locations, reflecting a name changes and existence of the Short Park, and may otherwise refer to the Park as such. All references to the parks (or as a defined term as “Park”) in City ordinances, resolutions, grants and other laws of the City are hereby amended to reflect the said renaming to Short Park.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BERKELEY, MISSOURI, RENAMING
SHORT PARK TO WILLIE MAE ANTHONY NEIGHBORHOOD PARK**

WHEREAS, Councilwoman Willie Mae Anthony was instrumental in the work of planning and monitoring Short Park, when it was vacant land; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, in recognition and honor is desirous of renaming Short Park to Willie Mae Anthony Neighborhood Park; and

WHEREAS, the City Council will work to have a monument installed at this park dedicating it to Willie Mae Anthony Ward Four, for her dedication in creating this Park for the residents of Ward Four. Councilwoman serves faithfully beautifying the city; and has received a Lifetime Service Award.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BERKELEY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. The City shall erect signage, in appropriate locations, reflecting the name and existence of the Willie Mae Anthony Neighborhood Park, and may otherwise refer to the Park as such. All references to this park (or as a defined term as "Park") in City ordinances, resolutions, grants and other laws of the City are hereby amended to reflect the said renaming to Willie Mae Anthony Neighborhood Park, see EXHIBIT A.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
