NATURE OF WORK

This position requires skills in the Pre-hospital treatment of patients. Rendering of pre-hospital emergency medical care and advanced life support measures to victims of accidents, fires or other emergency calls for service. This work is performed under stressful conditions in emergency situations where human life is in danger. Advanced life support work is performed through direct communication with (Medical Control) a physician at a nearby hospital and conforming to the standards set by the legislature of the State of Missouri in the 190.100-190.195 revised statutes as concerning emergency medical services. The work performed under the direction of the emergency department physician. In majority of cases, the paramedic is the most qualified medical authority on the scene. He/she must be able to understand the legal responsibilities and direct the operations in the best interest of the patient.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Responds to EMS alarms
- Drives equipment as required
- Renders Basic or Advanced life support to injured persons.
- Uses advanced life support techniques and equipment.
- Assists fire companies as requested, and attend any training as scheduled
- Performs general maintenance work in the upkeep of departmental quarters and equipment and operate ambulance units and the specific tools and special equipment maintained in this unit.
- Communicates with the hospital via telemetry and carries out the specific orders in the interest of the patient.
- Instructs CPR Classes and installs Child Safety Seats.

QUALIFICATIONS

Must have a High School Diploma or Equivalent. Must have a valid driver's license with a good driving record. Must have a valid Missouri Paramedic's (EMT-P) license to work as FF/EMTP. Must have current valid BLS, ACLS, PALS, PHTLS and CPR certifications.
