PERSONNEL RULES AND REGULATIONS TO INCLUDE COLUMBUS DAY
AS AN OFFICIAL CITY OBSERVED HOLIDAY BEGINNING IN YEAR 2023**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BERKELEY,
MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. In the calendar year 2023, the City shall observe Columbus Day as an official holiday of the City of Berkeley, Missouri. The City's Personnel Rules and Regulations shall be amended accordingly.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage.
