

City of Berkeley, Missouri City Council Meeting Virtual

February 6, 2023 Minutes

Meeting Called to Order:

Mayor Deinbo called the council meeting to order at 7:01pm.

Roll Call:

City Manager Mai-Lombardo, City Attorney Smith, Chief Jackson, Chief Linhardt, and City Clerk Jones were in attendance.

Councilman Hindeleh moved and Councilwoman Verges seconded the motion to approve the minutes for the 01-23-23 regular meeting.

Councilwoman-at-Large Crawford-Graham stated her question "How can a councilmember vote on a resolution of reimbursement to themselves?" was not answered to her satisfaction and the following statement should be added to the 1/23/23 minutes. "Robert Rules of Order states under the act a public official has a disqualifying conflict of interest if it is foreseeable that the decision will have a financial impact on his or her personal finances or other financial interest." The question was answered in the 01/23/23 meeting by the City Attorney that voting for the reimbursement resolution is not a personal gain for the council member and therefore not unethical. The council discussed that the statement was not given in the meeting and should not be added.

Councilwoman-at-Large Crawford-Graham moved and Councilman Hoskins seconded the motion to approve the 01-23-23 regular meeting minutes with corrections; adding the statement, "Robert Rules of Order states under the act a public official has a disqualifying conflict of interest if it is foreseeable that the decision will have a financial impact on his or her personal finances or other financial interest." given in the 02/06/2023 meeting, to satisfy the question asked in the 01/23/23 meeting about a council member not abstaining from voting for Resolution 3637 – Council Reimbursements for December 2022, that was for themselves.
