AN ORDINANCE FOR THE CITY OF BERKELEY, MISSOURI, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE ATTACHED RIGHT OF ENTRY AGREEMENT TO THE U.S. ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS (USACE), ST. LOUIS DISTRICT, FOR FROST AVENUE, FROST INDUSTRIAL LANE, ROMISS COURT, JONAS PLACE, AND HAZELWOOD AVENUE

- WHEREAS, the U.S. Army Corps of Formally Utilized Sites Remediation Action Program (USACE FUSRAP), St. Louis District, in its continuing efforts to clear Coldwater Creek (CWC) and adjacent properties of contamination, pursuant to FUSRAP guidance, requests permission to perform tests and remediate any impacts to the City of Berkeley property(ies); and
- WHEREAS, it is in the public interest that the USACE, St. Louis District, be given right of entry access for further investigation of areas along and within the Coldwater Creek 10-year flood plain.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BERKELEY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute a Right of Entry agreement with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE), St. Louis District, on Frost Avenue, Frost Industrial Lane, Romiss Court, Jonas Place, and Hazelwood Avenue in its continuing efforts to clear Coldwater Creek (CWC) and adjacent properties of contamination, pursuant to Formerly Utilized Sites Remedial Action Program (FUSRAP) guidance.
- **Section 2.** The attached agreement is hereby incorporated herein and made a part of this ordinance, as if fully set out herein.
- **Section 3.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage.

DEPARTMENT OF THE ARMY RIGHT OF ENTRY

Owner: City of Berkeley, Missouri

RE: Portions of the Rights-of-Way of Frost Avenue, Frost Industrial Lane, Romiss Court, Jonas Place and Hazelwood Avenue being the highlighted area on Exhibit "A"

The undersigned, hereinafter called the "Grantor," in consideration of the performance of remedial activities under the Formerly Utilized Sites Remedial Action Program (FUSRAP) by the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, hereinafter called the "Government," hereby grants to the Government, its agents, employees, representatives, contractors, subcontractors, and assigns, an irrevocable right of entry upon the property described above located in St. Louis County, Missouri, and more particularly described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto, subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. This Right of Entry is granted for purposes of performing surveys and investigations, collecting samples and making test borings, and remediating radiological and chemical contamination of soils, groundwater and structures including, but not limited to, the right to store, move and remove equipment and supplies; excavate and dispose of contaminated soil and backfill with suitable soil and restore the property to its previous condition; construct, operate, maintain, repair, replace, and remove groundwater extraction, treatment and injection systems and monitoring wells; and perform such other work as may be necessary and incident to implementation of the Formerly Utilized Sites Remedial Action Program for a period not to exceed **two (2) years** beginning with date of this instrument.

2. This Right of Entry includes the right of ingress and egress on other lands of the Grantor provided that such ingress and egress is necessary and not otherwise conveniently available to the Government.

3. All tools, equipment, and other property taken or placed upon the land by the Government shall remain the property of the Government and may be removed by the Government at any time within a reasonable period after the expiration of this Right of Entry.

4. The Government shall have the right to patrol and police the land during the period of this Right of Entry.

5. If any action of the Government in the exercise of the rights granted herein results in damage to the real property, the Government will, in its sole discretion, either repair such damage or make an appropriate settlement with the Grantor. In no event shall such repair or settlement exceed the fair market value of the fee simple title to the real property at the time immediately preceding such damage. The Government's liability under

this clause is subject to the availability of appropriations for such payment, and nothing contained in this agreement may be considered as implying that Congress will at a later date appropriate funds sufficient to meet any deficiencies. The provisions of this clause are without prejudice to any rights the Grantor may have to make a claim under applicable laws for any damages other than those provided for herein.
