**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY OF BERKELEY, MISSOURI, PERSONNEL RULES AND REGULATIONS TO INCLUDE THE DAY BEFORE THANKSGIVING AS AN OFFICIAL CITY OBSERVED HOLIDAY**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BERKELEY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:**

- Section 1.** In the calendar year 2024, the City shall observe the day before Thanksgiving as an official holiday of the City of Berkeley, Missouri. The City’s Personnel Rules and Regulations shall be amended accordingly.
- Section 2.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage.
