AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NOS. 4767, 4880, AND 4813 TO MODIFY THE SCOPE OF WORK FOR MULTIPLE MUNICIPAL PROJECTS CONTRACTED WITH CHIODINI ARCHITECTS AND ITS CONSULTANTS

WHEREAS, the City of Berkeley, Missouri previously approved multiple construction and improvement projects to be performed by Chiodini Architects, including:

Ordinance No. 4767 authorizing work under RFP #920 for a Public Works building and Fire House #2;

Ordinance No. 4880 authorizing work under RFP #948 for the Public Works Facility Warehouse Project; and

Ordinance No. 4813 authorizing work under RFP #935 for the renovation and conversion of Airport Elementary tot eh Berkeley Community Center; and

WHEREAS, budget constraints require modification of these projects' scope and timeline; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined it is in the best interest of the City to modify these projects while maintaining essential services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BERKELEY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

- **Section 1.** RFP #920 (Ordinance No. 4767):
 - 1. Remove construction of new Public Works building at N. Hanley and 5th Street.
 - 2. Proceed with Fire House #2 construction at 9363 Natural Bridge Road.
- **Section 2.** RFP #948 (Ordinance No. 4880):
 - 1. Suspend all work on the Public Works Facility Warehouse Project.
 - 2. Preserve all completed design work and documentation for future use.
 - 3. Place project on hold pending further project review and funding availability.
- **Section 3.** RFP #935 (Ordinance No. 4813):
 - 1. Suspend all work on the Airport Elementary renovation and conversion.
 - 2. Preserve all completed design work and documentation for future use.
 - 3. Place project on hold pending further project review and funding availability.

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.
