The use of a vehicle as a barricade is prohibited; 5) An approximate twelve-foot (12') emergency drive aisle shall remain clear at all times; 6) No alcoholic beverages shall be sold at any event; 7) The use of illegal fireworks is prohibited; and 8) The Open-Air Event Permit is limited to the date and time specified on the permit, but in no event shall it begin before noon on Sundays or continue after 11:00 pm.
