Mayor Crawford-Graham called the special meeting to order at 05:07pm, the notice was read.

Councilman Hindeleh moved and Councilwoman Holmes seconded Councilman Hindeleh’s nomination to reappoint Robert Schneider to the Police & Fire Pension Board. Roll Call: Holmes-Aye, Williams-Aye, Hoskins-Aye, Anthony-Absent, Hindeleh-Aye, and Mayor Crawford-Graham-Aye (Aye-5) motion passed.

Councilwoman Holmes moved and Councilwoman Williams seconded Mayor Crawford-Graham’s nomination to appoint Diane Phillips to the Civil Service Board. Roll Call: Holmes-Aye, Williams-Aye, Hoskins-Aye, Anthony-Absent, Hindeleh-Aye, and Mayor Crawford-Graham-Aye (Aye-5) motion passed.

Councilwoman Holmes moved and Councilman Hindeleh seconded Councilwoman Holmes’ nomination to appoint Margaret Green to the Betterment Commission. Roll Call: Holmes-Aye, Williams-Aye, Hoskins-Aye, Anthony-Absent, Hindeleh-Aye, and Mayor Crawford-Graham-Aye (Aye-5) motion passed.

Councilwoman Holmes moved and Councilwoman Williams seconded Councilwoman Holmes’ nomination to reappoint Gary Grotegeers to the Board of Adjustment. Roll Call: Holmes-Aye, Williams-Aye, Hoskins-Aye, Anthony-Absent, Hindeleh-Aye, and Mayor Crawford-Graham-Aye (Aye-5) motion passed.

Councilwoman Williams moved and Councilwoman Holmes seconded Mayor Crawford-Graham’s nomination to appoint Willie Mae Harris to the Board of Adjustment. Roll Call: Holmes-Aye, Williams-Aye, Hoskins-Present, Anthony-Absent, Hindeleh-Nay, and Mayor Crawford-Graham-Aye (Aye-3, Nay-1, Present-1) motion passed.

Councilwoman Williams moved and Mayor Crawford-Graham seconded Mayor Crawford-Graham’s nomination to appoint Councilwoman Holmes to the Board of Adjustment. Roll Call: Holmes-Nay, Williams-Abstain, Hoskins-Present, Anthony-Absent, Hindeleh-Abstain, and Mayor Crawford-Graham-Aye (Aye-1, Nay-1, Abstain-2, Present-1) motion failed.

Councilman Hindeleh moved, Councilwoman Holmes seconded, and the motion carried to go into a closed session at 5:35pm.

Councilwoman Holmes moved and Councilwoman Williams seconded the motion to allow Councilman Hoskins his ten candidates to interview. Roll Call: Holmes-Aye, Williams-Aye, Hoskins-Aye, Anthony-Absent, Hindeleh-Aye, and Mayor Crawford-Graham-Nay (Aye-4, Nay-1) motion passed. The total number of candidates ended up equaling fifteen.

The council gave a general consensus to interview on 02-18-26, 02-20-26, 02-23-26, and 02-25-26 all at 5pm, no more than two candidates each date. Interviews on 02-24th thru 02-26th from 10am-1pm.

Councilwoman Holmes moved and Councilman Hindeleh seconded the motion to close the meeting at 6:55pm.
